Tibet is the 2010-2012 Mission Explosion project working to support children at the "Top of the World," Lhasa, Tibet. The focal point of our project is at Tibet's first orphanage in support of children that otherwise would have no hope. Specifically, we will be replacing dormitories. One dorm was condemned by the government after suffering earthquake damage. This has resulted in these children having to share beds, sometimes as many as three or four in a single bed! The American Baptist Churches of Massachusetts (TABCOM) has been working with this orphanage/school since 2009. **Come with the team on a mission trip that puts our efforts where our values are!** We will work with children in the classrooms and with children in the Physical Therapy Room and the Kindergarten Room. We will embody Christ's love by going, sharing, teaching, learning and building relationships.
