


SAID & NADIA

POPULATION: 36,192,00

CHRISTIANS: 31,400

In North Africa, 8 million speak a Berber language called Tamazight. Thanks to Said's translation work, these people now have access to the Bible in their own language, as well as other resources such as original worship songs and the evangelistic Jesus movie in their native language.

Evangelism and discipleship are at the core of their ministry. Nadia leads small groups among women; Said leads a home group and disciples Muslim background believers students.

They also serve through an educational center, where there are more than 200 university students learning math, science, English and computer skills. There, they get to build new relationships in which they have the opportunity to share the Good News and have an important role in the community.

FADI & SARA

Fadi and Sara are both from Muslim backgrounds and came to faith in Christ through believers from their own country. Since then, they have been discipled by Lebanese missionaries and have begun sharing the gospel with their countrymen, mentoring new believers; they now lead a small church, with about 15 regular attendees.

With a focus on evangelism and discipleship, Fadi and Sara divide their time between reaching out to new people, building relationships and sharing the Gospel; as well as discipling new believers in their daily lives.

Their ministry is rooted in true biblical teaching that aims to help the group to grow in their knowledge of the Lord and to be able to disciple others.

Ahmad serves as a pastor at a church in the south of Egypt. However, as a Kingdom-minded person, he is involved in various events outside his church, where he contributes to training leaders. On one of these evangelistic trainings, he had the opportunity to take a group of participants to share what they have learned to another village close to them.



Rabiah and Rashida live in a small village, where they use the business in a mission strategy to serve the community. They established a small textile factory to help women in their village who struggle to meet the financial needs of their families, but now this small business expanded and began to provide other educational and health services to the community in the same building.

Rabiah is engaged in fruitful peacebuilding initiatives. He works with other Muslim and Christian peacebuilders toward promoting nonviolent coexistence, as the south of Egypt has for a long time witnessed various types of violence between believers of the two faiths. In this context, Rabiah has hosted a human development forum in cooperation with an important Egyptian organization, where over 50 people agreed to work towards nonviolent culture and promoting peaceful coexistence in the local community.

After having fled from militant groups a few years ago, M is taking tremendous risk relocating back to the same area to serve the Sunni community while developing a *Business in Mission* initiative. The goal is to help M settle in and be able to live among his family and community.

He has a great desire to share the gospel with the majority Muslim community in Egypt. As M lives in a predominantly Islamic region, he had to develop a special discipleship curriculum based on individuals who became followers of Jesus and would like to continue living in their community. M uses his own testimony of family reconciliation after many years of hostility to encourage others to do likewise and has now become a model for many Muslim background believers who are facing family persecution.

Ahmed and Priscilla lead a church in Cairo. Besides his weekly pastoral ministry, which includes preaching, pastoral care, developing leaders, and leading small groups, Ahmed is also gifted in the area of teaching. He prepares future Arab leaders by teaching the New Testament in two seminaries in Egypt.

Furthermore, Ahmed established new initiatives, in cooperation with other churches in the area, related to youth, young adult, family, and marriage. He also helps the Christians of his country in various areas such as developing leaders and pastoral care.



CHRISTIANS ARE ONLY 3.7% OF THE POPULATION

Christians in the Middle East and North Africa, the birthplace of Christianity, account for only 3.7% of the total population. Dwindling numbers are expected due to migration and persecution.¹

4,136 Christians around the world were killed for faith related issues in 2018 alone.²



The idea of running a small coffee shop began during the Soccer World Cup in June 2018. This *Business in Mission* initiative started simply by thinking of young people who like soccer and cannot afford to have a TV satellite, as they live in a poor remote area. This very successful endeavor gives Mada the opportunity to build new relationships with young individuals while generating income for his own personal needs.

In the past few months, Mada started a couple of discipleship groups among non-Christian people. Since then, a few have made the decision to follow Christ and now six of them are seeking Baptism.

At the moment, he is investing in many of these relationships, and he established a weekly prayer meeting to pray for those individuals.

Abdo & Grace are actively involved in ministering the Sudanese Darfuri refugees in Egypt. There are currently more than 1 million Sudanese refugees in Egypt, many of them with no documentation or legal rights. Abdo is currently leading efforts to train leaders to plant churches among the Sudanese community in Egypt and Sudan. Home groups have been growing and slowly multiplying as men and women are coming to Christ.

Abdo also pastors a church and trains new leaders in the *Inductive Bible Study* method, on how to form and lead Home Groups, Biblical Interpretation, Missional Church, Persecution of Believers, Lessons from the Bible and Christian History.

Having realized that many Sudanese refugees are suffering from traumas of war, they held a Trauma Healing Course in 2018, which led people to come to Christ and forgive those who committed crimes against them.

MIRLO & ESTHER

CHRISTIANS: 1,910,000

Mirlo is pastoring one of the largest churches in Sudan. Besides his pastoral role, which includes teaching, preaching, and pastoral care, Mirlo is leading an important Christian movement, which focuses on church planting, establishing discipleship and home groups, training leaders, doing jail ministry, and starting *Business in Mission* initiatives. He also serves as the key leader for Enduring Love in Sudan.

David runs a small hardware store supplying construction materials, paints, etc, with the purpose of generating income for himself as he serves as a church planter. Located in an undeveloped and poor neighborhood, where there is a need to build new houses, David's business contributes to the development of his community.

Additionally, David has been leading a ministry of small groups and also developing a small congregation, with the goal of planting a church in the near future.



LEBANON

MAROUN & SAMAH

Maroun and his family serve in pastoral care for a Syrian refugee community and congregation in a neighborhood of Beirut. His gifting at responding to crisis and pastoral empathy makes him very accessible to people that are in great need, who tend to refer to him in times of crisis.

As a leader of a local church, he has formed a team of first responders like himself, who welcome people to congregational meetings, strike up conversations with newcomers, help people know Christ, evangelize and share the Gospel with neighbors and strangers on the street, as well as care and provide for people's physical needs.

Working closely with a humanitarian aid ministry within the church, people under his care are referred to existing ministries within the church, including aid, discipleship, and volunteering and service.

Throughout the past year, Samuel has grown a lot in leadership and in character. God is using him to reach out to Syrian refugees in the community and disciple them, to bless the body of Christ with his administrative skills, and to be the hands and feet of Jesus to the refugee community.

Over the past year, he has been discipling 8 home groups, with members both from a Muslim and Christian background. Samuel is also sharing the Gospel with at least 15 young men in his community and helps to develop people by calling them to follow and practice the gifts that the Holy Spirit has poured on them.

His administrative skills ensure the smooth running of all the relief activities toward the Syrian congregation in Beirut, Lebanon, where he does regular assessment and follow-up visits and helps execute all the activities in the center.



LEBANON

ASHRAF & MIRNA

POPULATION: 6,100,00

CHRISTIANS: 1,830,000

Ashraf and Mirna are reaching out to Druze and Syrian families in a rural and mountainous area in Lebanon, sharing the good news of Jesus Christ and providing for their physical needs with monthly food and fuel vouchers.

Mirna teaches English and Arabic Literacy and Numeracy classes for women every week, as well as children's Bible classes. In cooperation with a local organization, she established a Women's Center, which aims to build bridges of communication between the Church and the Lebanese Druze community.

The center also enables women to earn their own living by teaching them handicrafts to help them establish a small business in the future.



Akram and Zainab are pastoring a growing church in Baghdad whose main focus is to disciple and train leaders. By the end of 2018, the church had 14 new leaders, and through the Inductive Bible Study, 14 home groups reached out to more than 100 families.

Zainab runs a training program for Sunday school teachers in Iraq and has already conducted five training sessions in various churches all throughout the country. Her plan for 2019 is to continue working alongside other Christian groups in Iraq.

Akram participates in inter-religious dialogue and his prophetic voice contributes significantly in shaping the future of the Iraqi Society. He also leads a relief team that helps 150 families affected by ISIS and had the opportunity to show Christ's love to families that were once part of ISIS.
