Annie and Jeff serve in Bangkok, Thailand. Annie is the founding CEO of NightLight International, a global organization compelled by love to reach out to, rescue, and restore the lives of those who have been negatively affected by sex trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation. NightLight Bangkok has

assisted over 175 Thai women through employment and repatriated over 150 trafficked women to their home countries.

Jeff teaches urban transformation at the invitation of local seminaries and serves as a chaplain for NightLight and as co-pastor of Song Sawang Church, which was founded with women from NightLight and has grown to include their children, extended family members, and neighbors.

MINISTRY STORY

NightLight's team has been reaching out to Sweetie and Sozo for many years. They came regularly to the beauty salon for a shower, clean clothes, and food, and to do their makeup before staying out all night. We wondered what it would take to set them free from a life of alcoholism, homelessness and prostitution.

One day, the alcohol poisoning was too much. Sweetie needed an ambulance. As she lay in the hospital, she heard the voice of God asking her to stop drinking. Sweetie decided that she was done drinking and needed to start a new life.

Sweetie started working at NightLight a week later. It's been seven months now, and she has not taken another drink of alcohol. She still sees her old drinking pals, but when they invite her to drink, she tells them, "I don't drink anymore. I have Jesus, and my heart is full." Sweetie has also decided to help her friend Sozo stay off the streets and begin a new life.

We are amazed at the miraculous life transformations that we have seen in

these women. The years of building relationships with them, as well as the many prayers poured out for them, have born wonderful fruit.

NightLight's team is there on the streets, shining the light of Christ and keeping hope alive.
