MINISTRY STORY

In the early years of my ministry, I worked under a model of needs-based outreach. This means that I used my skills as a nurse practitioner to treat health issues. As good as this sounds, I soon discovered that it was not the healthiest way to serve. This model did not acknowledge the God-given gifts of others.

I later learned about Asset-Based Community Development, a ministry model focused on identifying and using the resources and gifts already within a community. It required looking at ministry in a completely different way, often not doing as much as being in the community. It involved long conversations, building trust, listening, and learning from the community experts as well as being present when they simply needed me to stand with them.

Although the fruit of such efforts is often not seen for many years, last summer a local doctor in Bolivia whom I had worked alongside accepted Christ! I was blessed to be able to pray with her, answer her questions, and see the outcome of years of working together, where my simple presence had been more valuable than my skills as a nurse practitioner. She now serves not only as a doctor but as a Christian witness to her neighbors and those served by this ministry.
