MINISTRY STORY

One of the many blessings working in theological education and evangelism is when students not only understand what we teach but also apply the principles to their lives. We have seen this happen multiple times over the last few years.

One student, Juan, was working on his master's thesis for Palmer Seminary, with Peter as his mentor. Juan had trouble organizing his thoughts and connecting the concepts he was trying to present. Peter instructed Juan on how to state his point, support it with arguments and examples, and finally conclude his paper by restating his original point.

For Juan, this skill transformed not only his writing but also his sermons and leadership in the church. By the time his thesis was complete, Juan told Peter that his church board better understood his proposals and his members appreciated his clearer sermons.

Carmela was a student in the Master of Theology program for Latin America, a partnership between Palmer Seminary and IM. At the start of the second year, she was very discouraged. She was ready to give up on her calling to be a pastor and drop out of the program.

During the second-year residency week, God gave Peter and one of his IM colleagues, Mercy Gonzáles-Barnes, the opportunity to give Carmela spiritual direction. She shared with them later that, during this conversation, God spoke into her life and empowered her to continue through graduation.
