## “ MINISTRY STORY

Like most ministries in Latin America, bouncing back from the pandemic has been difficult. This has been especially true in Bolivia, where mask mandates were only just lifted at the beginning of 2023. It is no different for the ministry of the Fundación Proyecto de Esperanza. Fortunately, the main ministries of the FPE are in the areas of health and wellness, so we've had a sustaining presence in thirteen different churches and ministries in the greater metro area of Cochabamba, Bolivia.

We have been working with churches to take care of dental and general medical needs in a country with an overburdened medical system that has never fully recovered after the pandemic. Traveling to churches three weekends every month with medical and dental clinics that are

staffed by local volunteer doctors and dentists from the city, FPE works to provide a service for the ministries we support and stands alongside them as they minister to the needs of their local community.
