MINISTRY STORY

"I know the Bible calls them 'hungry,' 'thirsty,' 'a stranger,' and so on, but who really are 'the least of these'?" she asked. "Are they just people living in poverty?"

What a great question! Certainly, it would be easy to read Jesus' parable of the sheep and the goats in Matthew 25:31-46 at only face value. Honestly, isn't that what often happens with Scripture that becomes so familiar to us over time? We take it for granted, because the text seems so straightforward in what God is asking us to do.

But what happens when we look at that same Scripture through the lens of our world today? It's still true that "the least of these" are the hungry, the thirsty, the sick, and strangers, but the story doesn't stop there. The single mother struggling to get by, the immigrant seeking asylum from violence or persecution, the socially awkward teen feeling alone—these are "the least of these" as well. God calls us to care for them, too.
