

“ MINISTRY STORY

It wasn't that long ago that this work we've begun was nothing more than just thoughts and feelings. The thought of, "Hey, a camp might be a cool use of our land," or the feeling of warm grass under our feet and the Spirit in our hearts telling us, "This is where you should be!"

We never planned on being global servants. We loved living and ministering to the people of San Francisco, but little did we know that God was growing us and preparing us to serve his kingdom in the Philippines. God has called us to use our family's land on the island of Mindanao, to be a resource for churches in the area, and to reach the fertile hearts of the more than 30,000 children who live in our part of the island.

Even now, the property is bearing fruit—both spiritual fruit and crops to feed the community. Our first years of ministry have been focused on being a new family, in a new culture, getting comfortable with the language, and teaming together with our global partners in building community with

unbelievers. These first steps will segue into planning and building the camp, which we pray the Lord will use to have a big impact on our small part of his kin.
