**The 10th FJC Class will graduate on January 27 in Buffalo, NY**

The 10th graduation ceremony of [FOUNDATIONS Judson Communities'](#) program, **Certificate of Ministry Studies**, will be held in Buffalo, New York on January 27, 2018.

There are altogether 49 participants and 47 will be getting their certificates. They began their studies from September 30, 2017, and their last class will be on January 27, 2018. One from Cleveland, Ohio, four from Syracuse, New York and forty-four from Buffalo, New York attended the class.

This is also a milestone for Central Seminary. *CBTS is planning to upgrade the course to a diploma program and those who have received the Certificate of Ministry Studies through FJC could attend the upgraded program.*
