Pixi will. Pixi is a dread-locked, f-bomb-dropping humanitarian. He's not a follower of Jesus. In fact, he is a veteran of the Bosnian war. At the tender age of 15, he was a soldier. Larry told him about God's forgiveness. He said he doesn't want forgiveness from God, but from

the mothers of the men he shot. Pixi now spends his life caring for refugees, those on the very outskirts of humanity. Today, Larry had the rare privilege of buying medical supplies and then watching Pixi help others. Look at Pixi's smile in the picture above.
