### GOAL

International Ministries seeks to raise \$7,500 through White Cross for the Kwai River Hospital

## **SUMMARY**

This White Cross project seeks to raise \$7,500 to help change the quality of patient care by providing important sanitary medical supplies to create a clean environment for healing at the Kwai River Christian Hospital in northern Thailand.

## **DESCRIPTION**

The goal of the Kwai River Christian Hospital (KRCH) is "Ministry to the Least". Annually they serve thousands of people, regardless of ethnicity, along the Thai/Burma border. The KRCH also administers a "Safe House" project, the Candlelight community-based rehab program and an HIV/AIDS ministry.

This work is done in collaboration with the 16th church district of the Church of Christ in Sangklaburi, Kanchanaburi Thailand. KRCH also hosts a malaria and flu research project with the Armed Force Research Institute for Medical Sciences (AFRIMS) as well as a "Tuberculosis reduction among migrants" project.

The medical staff maintains a high standard of patient care and concern for each individual, while sharing the Gospel so there is healing for the whole person.

In addition to the gifts listed here, White Cross funds will also be used to buy gowns for patients, sheets, gauze, towels, plastic sheeting and hospital uniforms.

## **SUGGESTED GIFTS**

\$100 will buy 10 dozen sanitary pads for female patients

\$250 will buy 50 dozen sterilized surgical gloves

\$500 will buy jackets for medical staff
